What is Tukes?

Tukes is an innovative and ever expanding service that enables people with mental health problems and other disadvantaged people to gain new skills, increase their confidence, self-esteem, motivation and quality of life.

What do we do?

At Tukes we provide hands on training, education and employment opportunities to people who have little or no previous training, qualifications or work experience, thereby counteracting social exclusion within the local labour market.

Why was Tukes established?

Tukes was established in July 2003, since then it is fair to say that it has grown beyond all expectations, taking over from the old style day hospitals that offered very little in terms of training and employment to a community with very high unemployment rates.

Work experience

Members can, by being part of this real business, receive training and practical skills in a wide variety of occupational areas including:

- Domestic, laundry and caretaking
- Horticultural and grounds maintenance
- Building maintenance (property services)
